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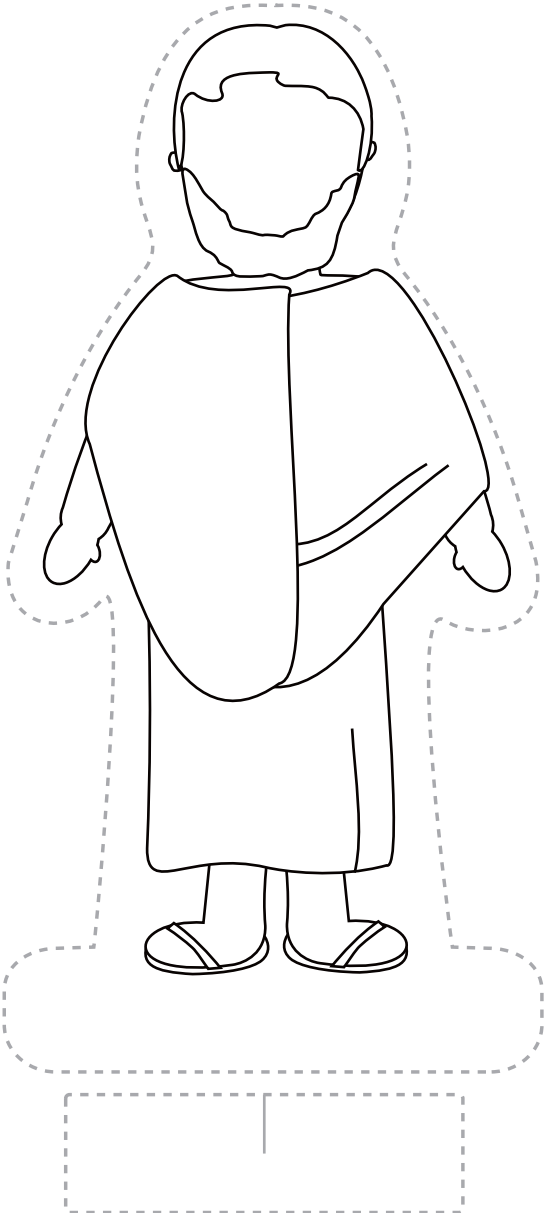
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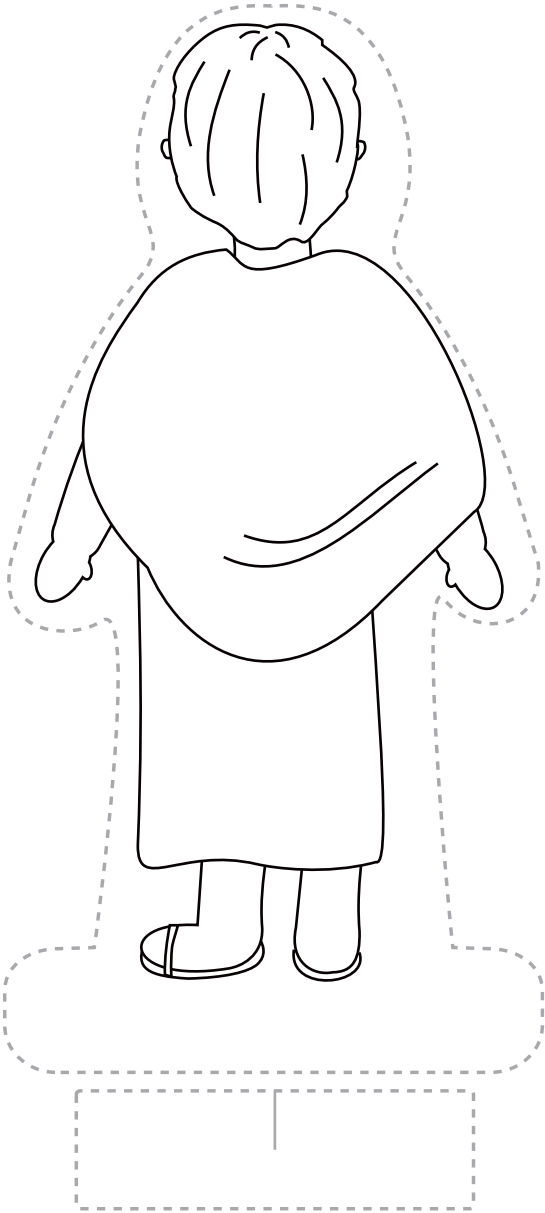
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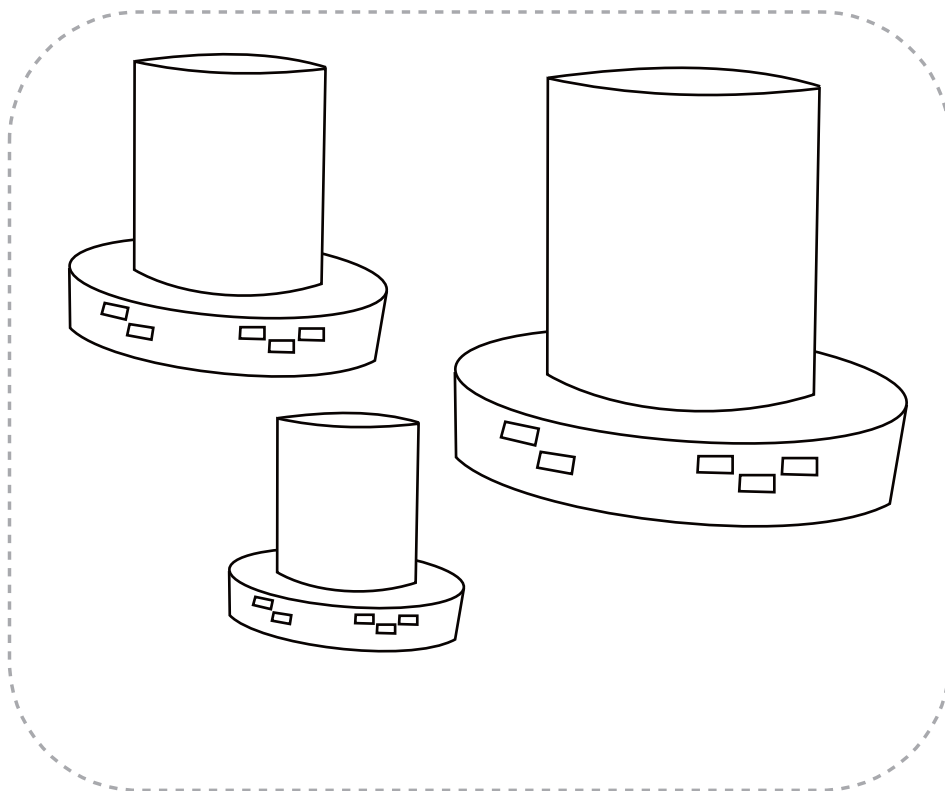


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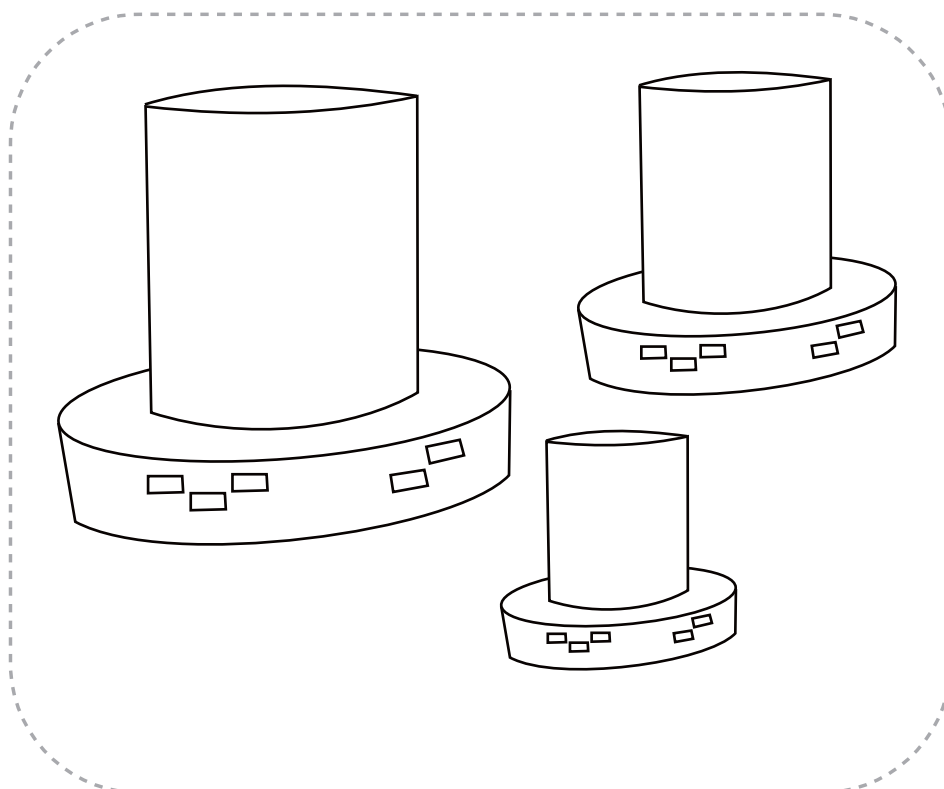


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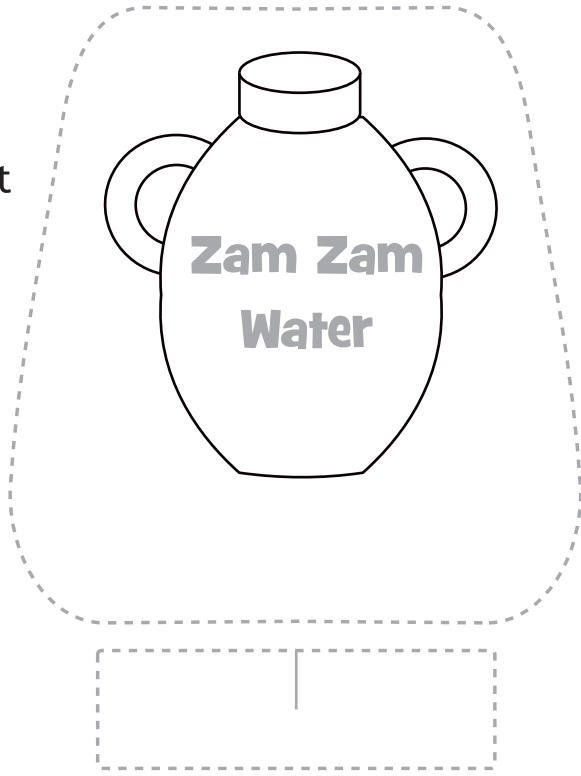


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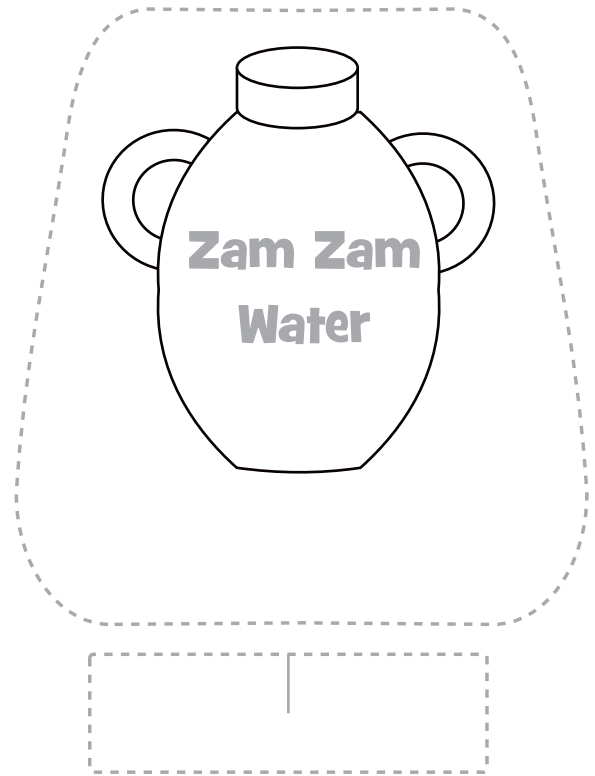


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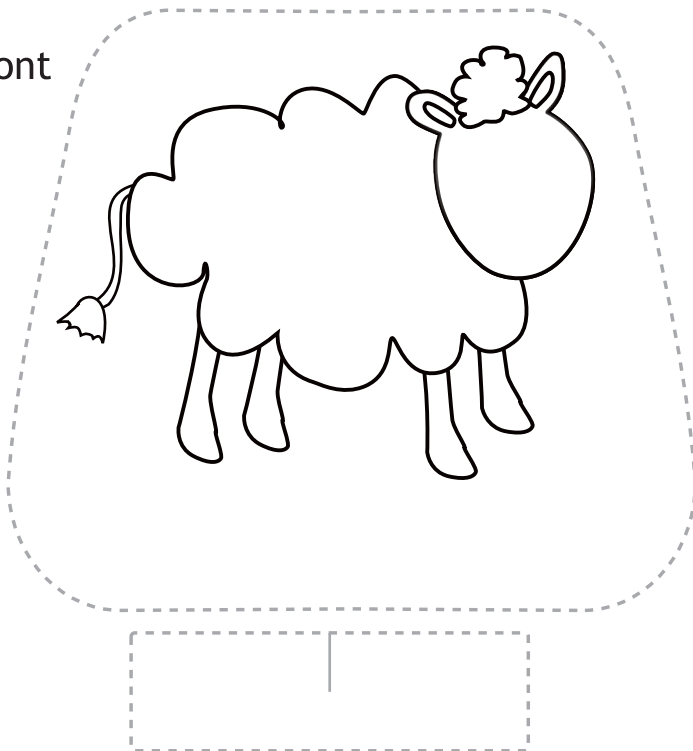
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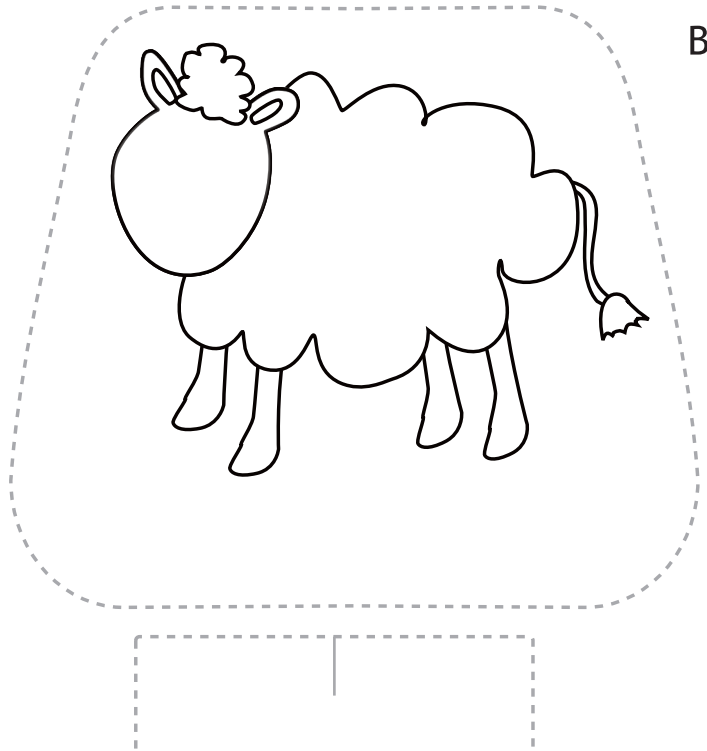
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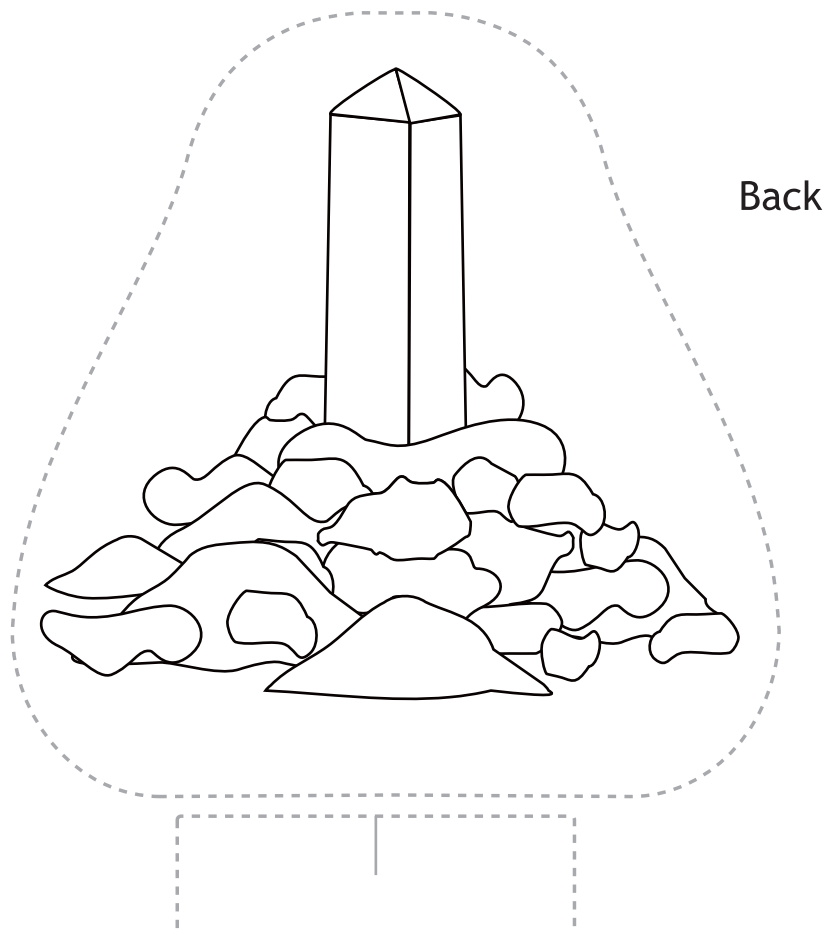
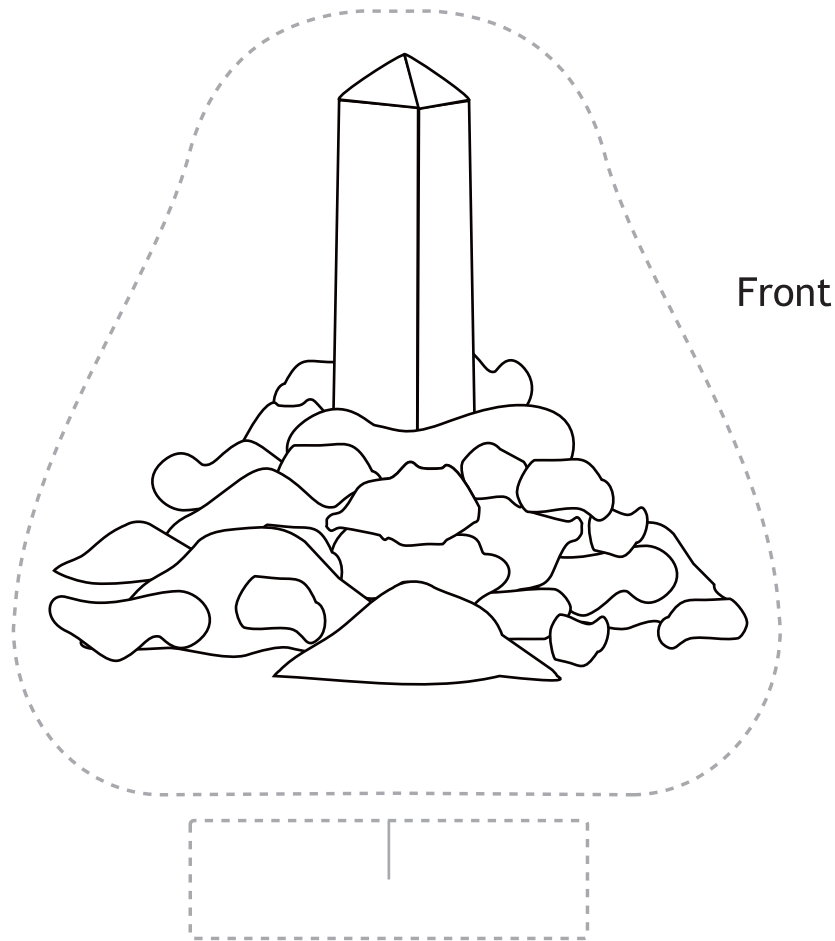
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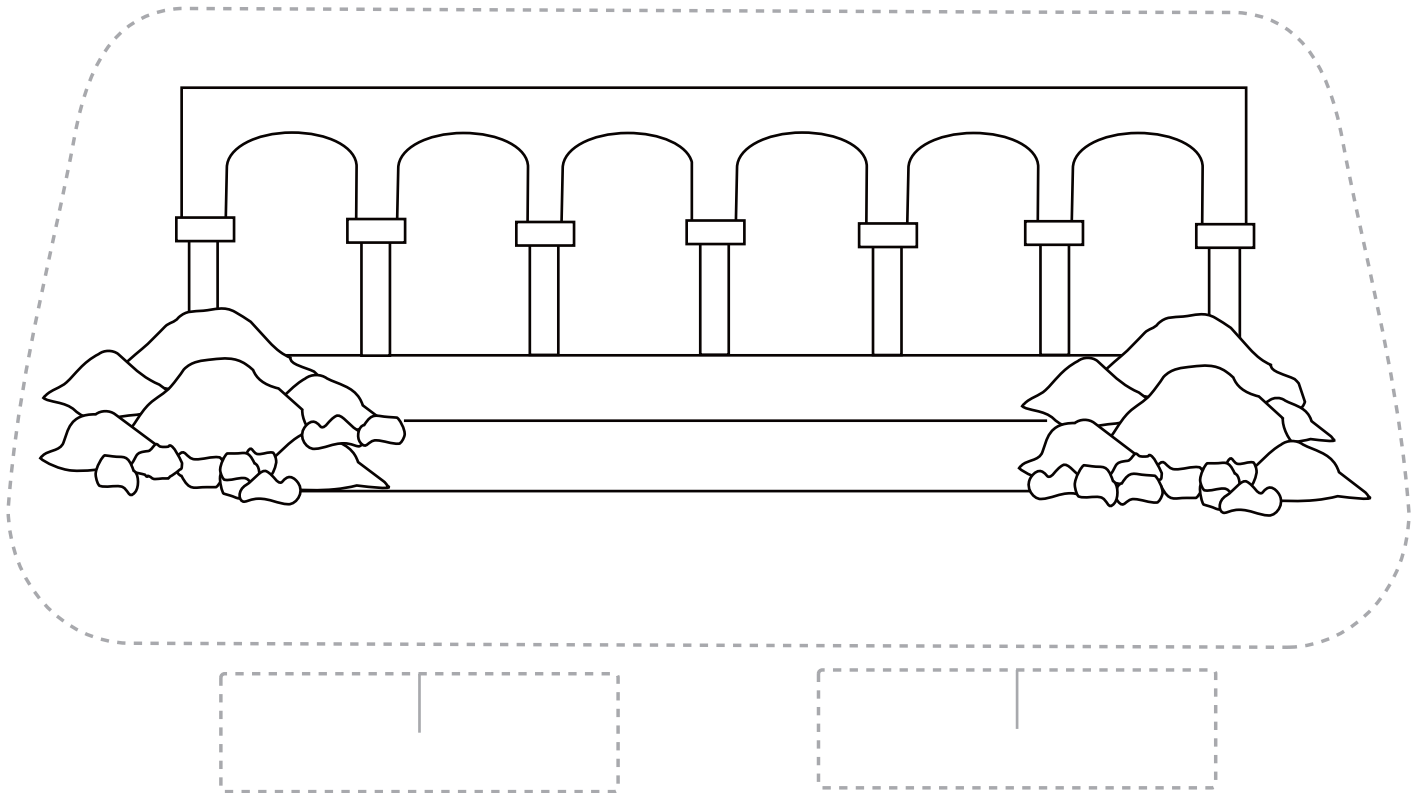


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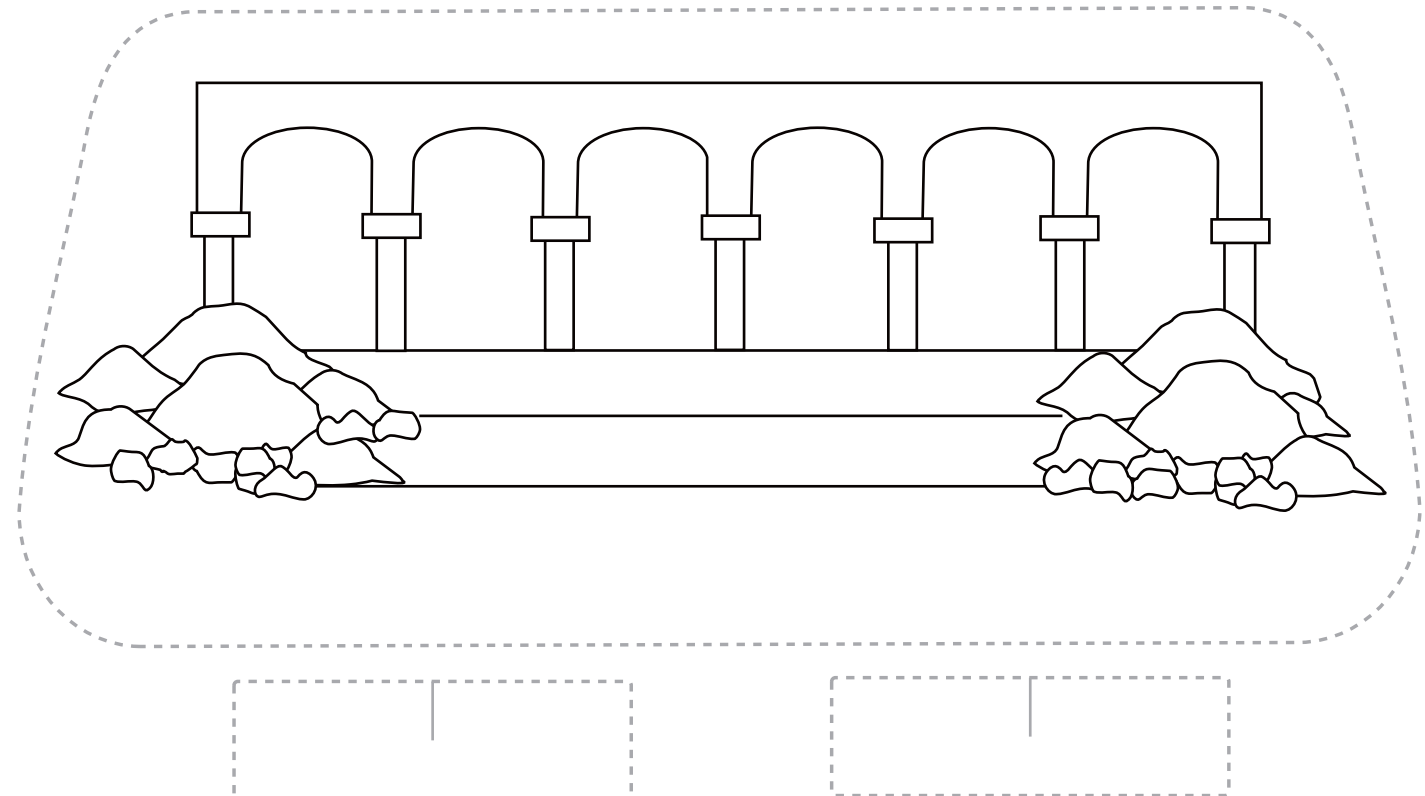


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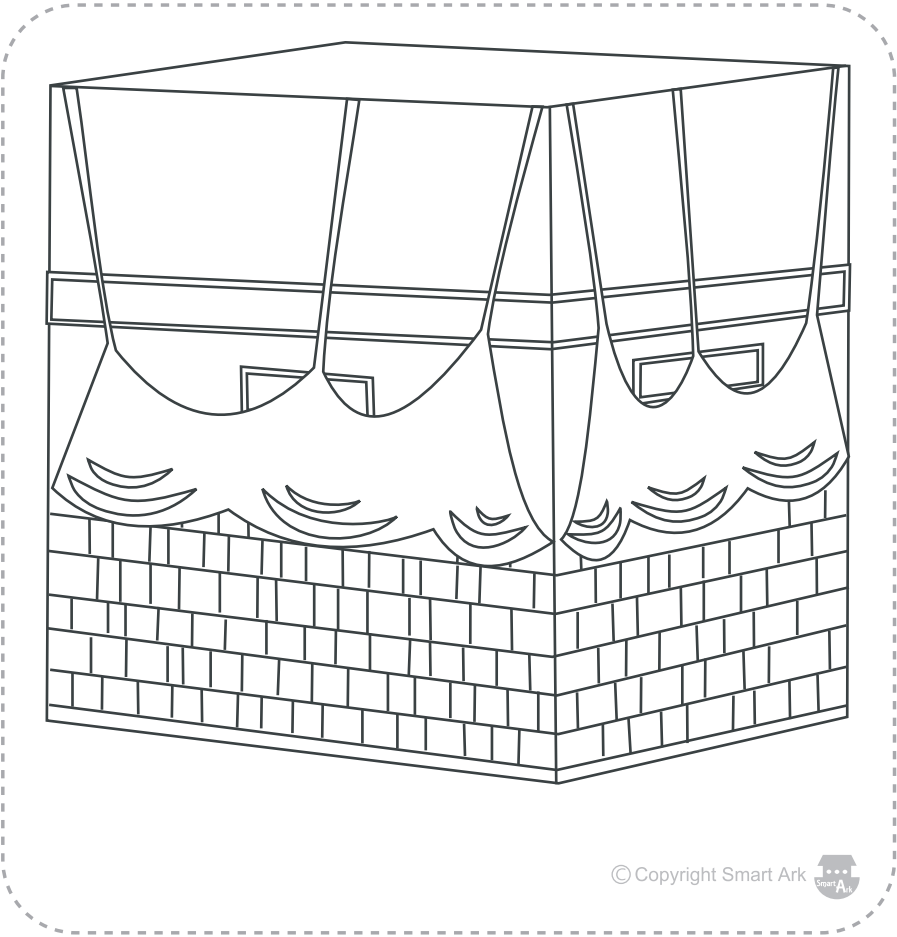


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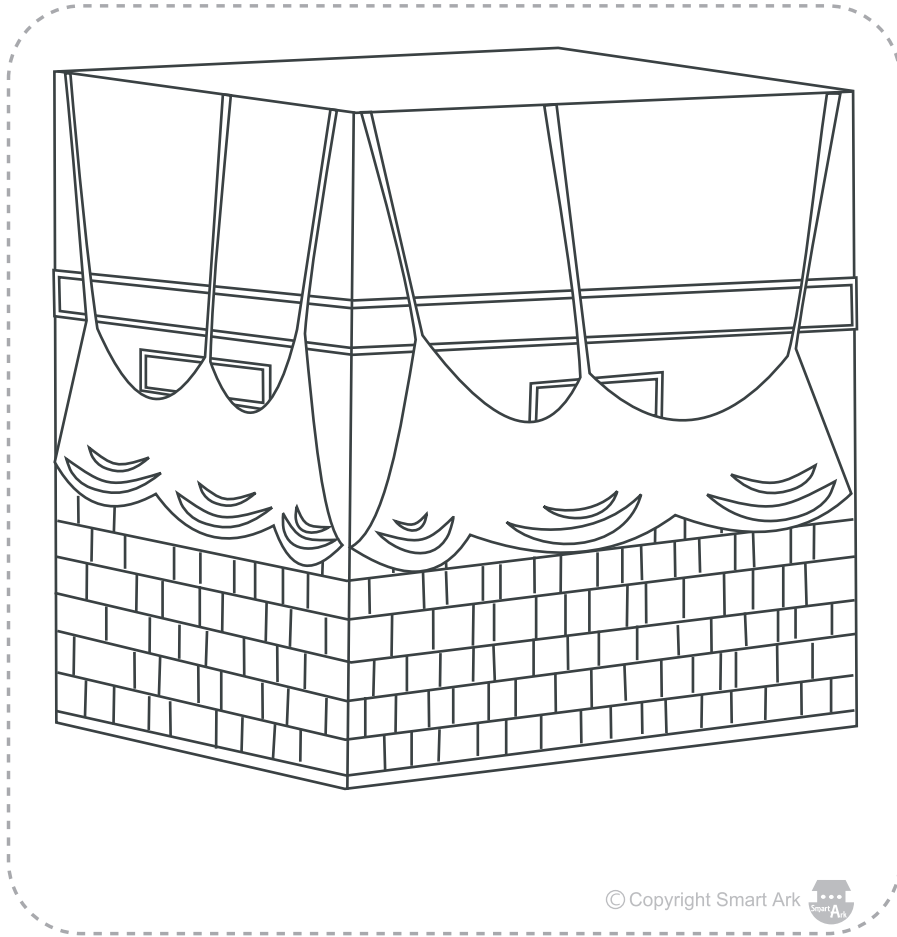


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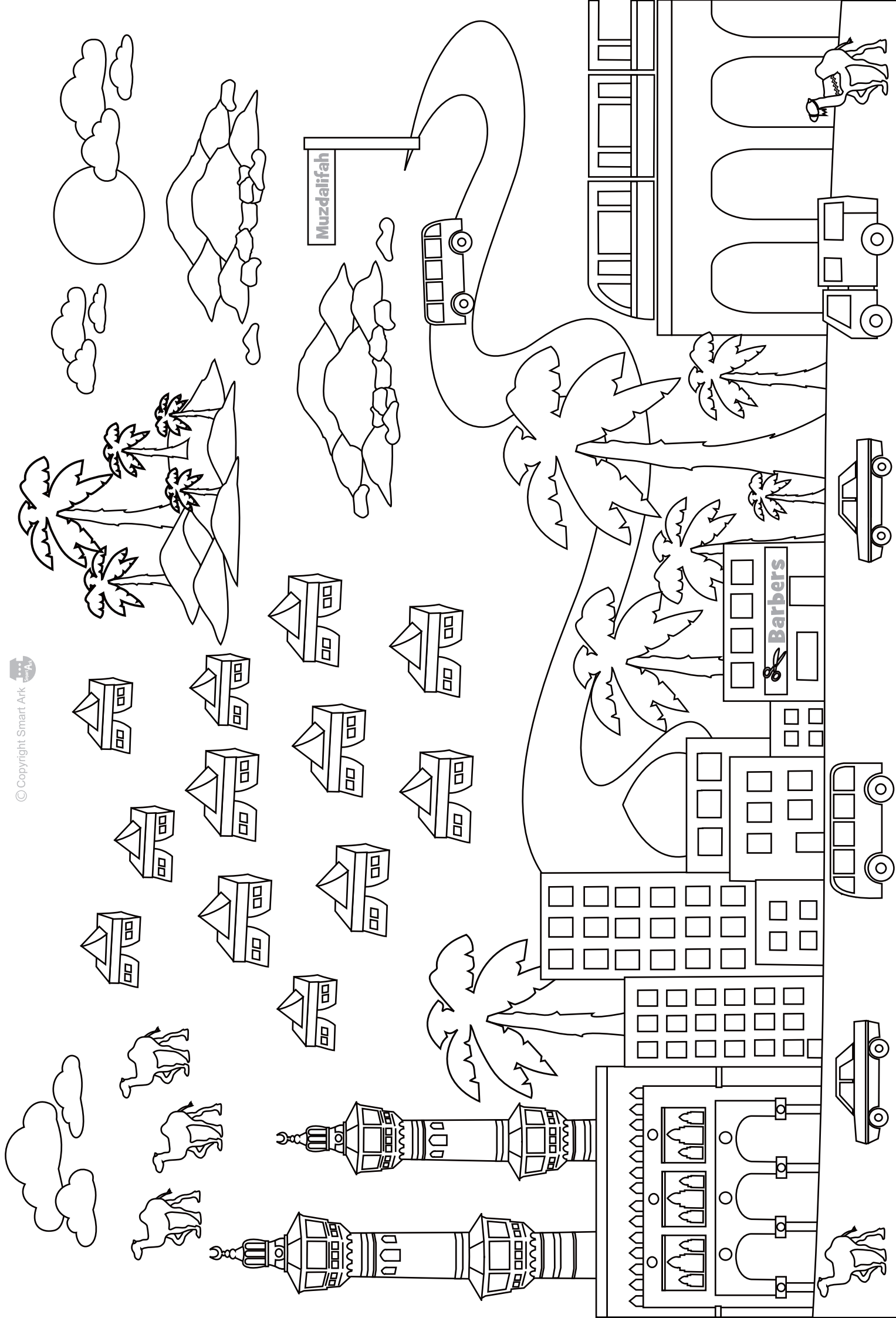


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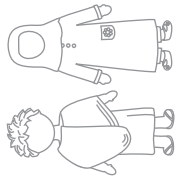
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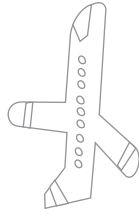


Hajj Words

Ihram: Clothes you wear for Hajj. Men wear 2 pieces of unstitched cloth. Women wear the full hijab and only show their hands and face.



Meeqat: The place where you make your intention for Hajj. There are 5 different places to do this.



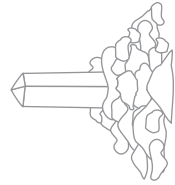
Talbiyyah: Is a special prayer you recite during Hajj:
Labbayk Allahumma labbayk.
Labbayk La shareeka laka Labbayk
Innal-hamda wan-ni'mata, laka wal mulk. La shareeka lak.
Here I am O Allah, here I am.
Here I am, You have no partner,
Here I am. Verily all Praise, and blessings are Yours, and all Sovereignty, You have no Partner.



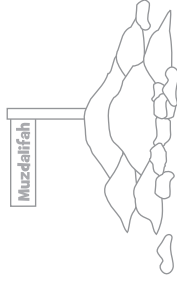
Mina: A place where you stay in tents and pray to Allah, read the talbiyyah and make du'a.



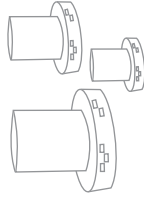
Arafah: You spend the day at Arafah and do lots of Dhikr, make du'a and ask for Allah's forgiveness.



Muzdalifah: You spend the night at Muzdalifah and collect pebbles for "stoning" the Jamarat.



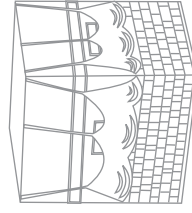
Jamarat: The three pillars that represent shaytan. You use the stones you collected in Muzdalifah and throw these at the jamarat pillars.



Udhiyyah: To sacrifice an animal as an act of worship to Allah. You share the meat out, give some to charity and keep some for yourself.



Tawaf: This is when you go around the Ka'bah seven times.



Sa'i: When you walk back and forth between the two mountains of Safa and Marwa.
